## **RULES OF THE KITHIVERSE!**

- Don't be a jerk. Golden rule applies.
  - Always ask permission before touching, photographing\*, or recording\* someone else.
  - Proactively ask for and respect safewords.
  - Respect the names and pronouns someone gives you to use for them.
  - Always clean up after any scene you participate in. This includes putting away any games you play, throwing out any trash you create, cleaning and sanitizing any dungeon gear you borrow, etc.

#### \*See photo policy

- Don't cross the streams.
  - Alcohol stays in the social rooms\*\*
  - Board games stay in the gaming room
  - Kink toys and furniture stay in the dungeon
  - Cuddly aftercare things stay in the aftercare room
- This event is created as a safer space for the hosts and their friends.
  - Do not bring (or arrive under the influence of) drugs or medication not prescribed to you.
  - Treat the space and the loaned equipment with respect. Damaging the room or our gear could prevent us from throwing more of these parties.
  - No exposed genitals, genital manipulation or contact in any of our party space, including the dungeon. Aka: no sex of any sort, and minimum dress code is "cover your butt and genitals" (thong, kilt, panties, beach wear bottoms, etc)
  - Hosts have the final say on any decision regarding the event.

#### Safewords:

- Party-wide Green is "ananab", "green" or snaps. You are encouraged to use this
  anytime you want to acknowledge/agree/encourage something that was said or
  encourage a top to continue.
- Party-wide Yellow is "banana", "yellow" or raised crossed fingers above your head.
   When you see/hear it, pause as soon as you can and check in with the person calling it.
   You are encouraged to use this for any reason in which you need a pause in conversation or a scene.
- Party-wide Red is "red" or a <u>raised fist</u>. If you see/hear it, stop what you are doing immediately, and be quiet. Allow a host (and the scene's top where relevant) to address the situation. You are encouraged to use this for any reason in which you need a scene or conversation to end immediately.

#### Invitations:

- If you start to make the space unsafe for someone else, you may be asked to leave.
- This space is invite only. It is not for friends-of-friends. If you want to bring someone, make an effort to introduce them to a host before the party. Only hosts should be extending invitations, and any host can deny an invitation for any reason.

## **Dungeon Rules**

Please put all phones, tablets, cameras, and other personal electronics away when in dungeon space. If you have no safe place to put them, talk to a host.

Minimum dress code applies - Cover your genitals. While some would love to see what you've got, we prefer to err on the side of keeping the party spaces clean and dry.

Event safeword is "**RED**"

### Types of play requiring approval:

- Any play that takes a large amount of space (Whips, darts, struggle, etc)
- Messy Play (Wax, food, paint, etc)
- Knife Play

### Types of play <u>not</u> permitted in public spaces at this party:

- Intentional drawing/release of bodily fluids (including urine, feces, blood, mucus, excessive saliva)
- Sexual acts including any combination of genitalia with other genitalia and/or body parts. This is much more of a sensual than a sexual-oriented party. Please plan accordingly.

There will be at least one host on hand at all times for assistance.

# PHOTO POLICY

<u>NO</u> PHOTOS ALLOWED IN DUNGEON. PERIOD.

Photographer is to ask consent of every subject either before photo OR as soon as possible, in the case of candid shots and the like.

Must delete photos immediately if asked by primary subject(s)\* - if not, considered consent infringement - <u>SEE CONSENT POLICY</u>

Photos are not to be uploaded or used to any purpose, public or private, without consent of primary subject(s)\*

\*Primary subject(s) means those in foreground of photo. Anyone in background of photo should have identity reasonably obscured unless consent is obtained.
